Minutes of the Town of Johnsburg Planning Board Meeting January 2, 2012

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Planning Board of the Town of Johnsburg held on Monday, January 2, 2012 at 7:00pm at the Tannery Pond Community Center, North Creek, NY.

Chairperson Osterhourt called the meeting to order at 7:00pm

Roll call showed the following persons present: Dottie Osterhout, Cork Nester, Roger Smith, Janet Konis, Nate Pelton, Tim Record – Bill Heidrich absent Also present was attorney for the planning board, Mike Hill

Guests: (nobody signed it)

Approval of minutes as submitted via email to the members – Motion by Second by All in favor

Site Plan #156-11: Little House B&B, River Road, Riparius was discussed- 2 bedrooms available for use by public- owner on site – sign drawing was submitted; to be unlit – facility has one bath; maximum occupancy is 4 people. No need for Dept. of Health or Fire Code at this point. Facility has new 1000g septic parking on site-Cork mad a motion to approve conditional upon Dept. of Health confirmation and ZEO inspection with a second by Roger – All if favor– Mike Hill questioned the need for a SEQR and one was completed during meeting with a determination of negative declaration by Roger, second by Janet, All in favor.

Site Plan #157-11: Seven Sister's- Main Street, North Creek - Nancy Dunn in attendance. Will mainly be sale of crafts- maybe coffee and baked goods in future – agricultural department for jurisdiction – not DOH – only requesting approval for craft sales at this time–parking on the street; sign as submitted with down lights; 21x36 inches – claims to have new 1000 g septic but needs documentation. Submitted agency designation form –SEQR done during meeting and resulted in a negative declaration as motioned by Roger and second by Cork -AIF) – Motion to approved application with the conditions of approval/modification of sign size by the ZEO and confirmation of septic size by Cork, second by Roger, AIF

Site plan amendment –Wevertown County Store – applicant was not present – tentative plan for Post Office to move into store with a 150 box limit –to be on agenda for 1/23/12 meeting

Sub division #179-11a – FrontStreet Mountain Development – Dan Smith present as representative. They want to add 10' feet to existing lot to accommodate the waste-water system. Motion by Roger, second by Cork – AIF

Preliminary site plan review for Dave and Kathy Waite for the building previously known as the North Creek Deli and Marketplace, Main Street, North Creek – plans include for first floor to be 1/3 deli and 2/3 retail. Agricultural Dept. jurisdictional, not DOH – 2^{nd} floor to be retail for rental – fire exit to be added on South side and window to be added on the East side. Will add 2 restrooms on first floor – one being handicap accessible/unisex – limit 20 seats – has 1000g septic and 2 dry wells. Will possibly construct stair access to Railroad Place – Signage to be on existing pole – "Izzy's Market & Deli" – may be on February agenda.

Ward Hill representatives were not in attendance but will be on the 1/23/12 agenda.

Sub division #226-11 – 4v's Development - represented by Dan Smith - original map dates back to 1979 shows cul-de-sac in the wrong location (snow plow turn around) –the road is owned by town – this subdivision requires a public hearing –it's a unique situation as class A jurisdiction with the APA for 9 of 13 lots other 4 are jurisdictional to the town – Motion to set public hearing 1/23/12 at 7pm by Roger, second by Cork – AIF

Site plan #155-11a and Special Use Permit #300-11: White Water Challengers – Zip line and Paint ball – Nate recused himself – applicant was present to answer the letter of 12-19-11 from the ZEO – explained the elements of zip line course and subject detail. Has pre-existing restroom facilities and will have porta-pots – EMS can access within 100' of site – Roger requested merger all documents for public hearing – discussed paint ball experience and zip line platforms & set up and safety attachment system – parking on site for 25 – directional sign discussed - proposed a 4x6 ' sign –hours of operations to be 8a-8p Mon, Wed & Fri – and weekends – staff includes 1 guide per 8 guests – 1 referee per 10-15 guests in paint ball, other staff on duty, 1 zip guide per 10 participants – car parker on duty – possibly rope off lot like gore does for organization – discussed size and height restrictions for harness; min. age of 10 years old – APA perm issued – Motion to set public hearing for 1/23/12 by Roger, second by Janet - AIF

Regular meeting was followed by discussion of FrontStreet bond release and availability of vouchers for planning board conference.

Motion to adjourn at 9:40p by Cork, second by Roger - AIF
