

**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION
SUBJECT TO PERMISSIVE REFERENDUM**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that at a regular meeting held on April 6, 2021, the Johnsbury Town Board, Warren County, New York, adopted a Resolution which is subject to permissive referendum pursuant to Town Law Sections 91 and 172-c. The North Creek Fire District (“Fire District”) and the Johnsbury Fire Protection District (“FPD”) serve different areas of the Town of Johnsbury. For many years, the Town has contracted with the Fire District to provide fire protection services to a portion of the FPD as shown on the map on file with the Town Clerk (the “Extension Area”). The Town Board determined that it would be to the mutual benefit of the Town and the Fire District and in the best interests of the Town, the FPD, the Fire District and those persons and properties within the Extension Area for this area to become part of the Fire District and no longer be included within the FPD. In order to make these changes, the Resolution approved (1) alteration of the boundary of the FPD to exclude the Extension Area and (2) extension of the Fire District to include the Extension Area. The portion of the Resolution which approves and authorizes alteration of the FPD boundary to exclude the Extension Area is subject to permissive referendum and shall not take effect until such time as provided by law. Such Resolution affirms and ratifies actions of the Town Board at its December 20, 2020 meeting where there were two mistaken references to the Johnsbury Fire Protection District, incorrectly referencing the North Creek Fire Protection District.
