

SHEEP MARKS TOWN OF JOHNSBURG

Recorded March 17, 1812

Henry Allen's sheep mark is to be a swallow fork in the end of the right ear.

John Parker's sheep mark is to be two notches under the left ear.

Recorded July 9, 1812

Jonathan Barney, Sr.'s sheep mark is and is to be a halfpenny underside of the right ear.

Recorded Feb. 15, 1816

Robert Gilchrist's mark for cattle, sheep & hogs is and to be a crop off the right ear and a nick under the left ear.

Recorded June 3, 1816

Nicholas Roosevelt's sheep mark is and to be a square crop off the top of each ear.

Recorded Aug. 8, 1816

Silas Herrington, Sr.'s sheep mark is and to be two holes in each ear.

Recorded July 11, 1817

Betsey Hill's mark for sheep is and to be a square crop off each ear and a half penny under the left ear.

Recorded Jun. 2, 1820

John D. Dunn's sheep mark is and to be two holes in the left ear and a slit in the right ear.

Recorded Mar. 1821

Clark Burdick's mark for sheep is and to be a slit in each ear.

Recorded May 31, 1822

Christian Whitaker's sheep mark is and to be a crop off the right ear and a slit in the left ear.

Recorded Aug. 1822

Nathaniel Petty's sheep mark is and to be a crop off the right ear.

Recorded Jun. 15, 1825

Thomas Somerville's sheep mark is to be a halfpenny on the left ear on the underside.

Recorded Jun. 17, 1833

Levi Hitchcock's sheep mark is to be a halfpenny on the right ear on the underside.

Recorded Feb. 1840

Zail G. Harrington's sheep mark is and to be a swallow fork in the end of the right ear.
