RESOLUTION #126-21

WHEREAS, the Town of Johnsburg ("Town") has identified the installation of public wastewater infrastructure as critical to expanding economic development opportunities in the community, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Empire State Development ("NYSESD") has announced the availability of funding through Empire State Development Grant Funds ("Grant Program"), and

WHEREAS, through the Grant Program eligible communities may submit applications for projects, not to exceed 20% of total project cost with 10% match requirement, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Champlain – Lake George Regional Planning Board ("LCLGRPB") will prepare an application for the Town and if awarded the LCLGRPB will assist the Town with grant administration and project delivery, and

THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Town of Johnsburg authorizes the LCLGRPB to submit an application to the NYSESD Empire State Development Grant Funds to assist the town with implementing the North Creek Wastewater Infrastructure project.

• Resolution authorizing submission of a grant for an update to the town's comprehensive plan

RESOLUTION #127-21

Mr. Stevens presented the following resolution and moved its passage with a second from Ms. Arnheiter as follows:

WHEREAS, the Town of Johnsburg ("Town") realizes the benefits of maintaining an up-to-date comprehensive plan, and

WHEREAS, the Town wishes to update the comprehensive plan, which was last adopted in 2005, and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of State ("NYSDOS") has announced the availability of funding to communities wishing to develop and/or update comprehensive plans through the Smart Growth Comprehensive Planning Grant Program ("Grant Program"), and

WHEREAS, through the Grant Program eligible communities may submit applications for projects, not to exceed \$100,000 with 10% match required, and

WHEREAS, the Lake Champlain – Lake George Regional Planning Board ("LCLGRPB") will prepare an application for the Town and if awarded the LCLGRPB will assist the Town with grant administration and project delivery, and

THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Town of Johnsburg authorizes the LCLGRPB to submit an application to the NYSDOS Smart Growth Comprehensive Planning Grant Program to allow the Town to develop an updated Town Comprehensive Plan.
