Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that moneys levied and collected in the Town for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the State for State Aid for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$400,000.00 shall be set aside to be expended for primary work and general repairs upon 94 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or renewals thereof.
