- Update on planned summer work at beach in Ski Bowl park: electrification, aeration, benthic mats in place before swim season begins; Fall drain and dredge to rid pond of weeds and muck; pea gravel distributed; Cedarwood Engineers doing "study" on pond to satisfy DOH requirements; looking to have public beach restored by summer 2015. Grant being written now to find money for terracing, landscaping, new bath house, docks.
