  - Six swim counselor applicants have had a swim test conducted by Susanne Hayden and found to be good, solid swimmers. One other teen counselor will be tested this week. We also have three teen sub counselors who are excellent swimmers.
  - There will be three counselors who hold a lifeguard certificate and will both lifeguard and teach.
  - A decision not to hire adult swim counselors passed unanimously as there are enough teens to comprise the staff.
  - Adults to be hired are Susanne Hayden as our aquatics director who will be in charge of the swim program and the counselors; Our bus driver will be Anna Goodman who will also be our beach supervisor when children are not in the water
