**December Minutes:** Motion to accept minutes, seconded and approved by all.

**Financial Report:**

- *Town Budget:* Starting new for the year. Noted that there is some money put aside for soccer – Mike brought up that it's possible Rob Wing will do a 12U team at the dome. \$510 is in the town budget for ski lessons; students pay the remaining amount (17 students Gore Ski Lessons). \$110 from town for Ski Bowl lessons; students pay the remaining amount (11 students Ski Bowl Lessons – 1 is free complements of Gore).
- *Grants Account:* \$5911 – is remaining in the grants account. \$786.05 will be coming out for Kate's materials and instruction for her programs. About half of the money comes from LARAC. They have promised \$1200 for this upcoming year for arts programs.
- \$150 was received by North Warren Central School for their students participating in ATLAS. Will be deposited in the grants account.
- Kelly will write a grant request for the Holiday Match; Kate will write one for the Community Fund.
- LARAC expects a final year-end report (via form).

**Updates:**

- *Ski Lessons:* As reported above; 29 total students served with ski lessons with Gore and Little Gore combined.
- *Soccer:* 14 U/two co-ed teams played dome soccer; 12 U/one team played. A lot of kids were new to it this time around; many kids improved their game. 1.12.16 is the last 14 U game.
- *School Year:* Kate submitted ideas for the remaining school months in 2015-2016 year. Events Jan/Feb: Wild Center Free Community Day 1.18; Kid Zumba and Healthy Snacks with Kim Smith; working on - Winter Vacation Camp February break; Pickle Ball; Knitting Circle; Ceramics that would get auctioned off and others used at Izzy's.
- *ATLAS:* \$926 was raised for Make a Wish in December. The three schools each raised about \$100; the rest was raised at the Aviation Mall on December 20. Next session is January 23 at Tannery Pond with John Robinson – a man with no legs and no arms due to a birth defect. Send a press release to the town (Joanne Morehouse) with pictures about the Make-A-Wish fundraiser.
- *Hiring:* Two town board meetings went by without discussing the hiring protocols & wage recommendations that were submitted to the board in November. Kelly will stop by town hall and meet with Ron this week before the next town board meeting.
