Section 1. The Town of Johnsburg hereby elects to provide all its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 665, Laws of 1984.

Section 2. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be November 10, 1984.

Section 3. The open period during which eligible employees may retire and receive additional retirement benefit, shall be eighty-two (82) days in length, commencing on November 10, 1984 and closing on January 30, 1985.

Section 4. The actuarial present value of the additional retirement benefits payable pursuant to the provisions of this Local Law shall be funded over a five (5) year period. The amount of the annual payment in each of the five years shall be determined by the Actuary of the New York State Employees' Retirement System, and it shall be paid by the Town of Johnsburg for each employee who receives the retirement benefits payable under this Local Law.

Section 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
