### MR. FUSCO & MS WRIGHT - SPEED REDUCTION - RIVER ROAD

Mr. Olesheski stated if folks in the town come to the board requesting a speed reduction on their road, let's do it. Supervisor Vanselow stated that 25 mph on the unpaved portion of River Road is a reasonable request, especially the seasonal section.

### **RESOLUTION # 135-14**

Mr. Olesheski presented the following resolution and moved its passage with a second from Mr. Arsenault to accept the written request from Mr. Fusco & Ms. Wright to establish a speed limit reduction to 25 miles per hour for the unpaved portion of River Road, a Town Road in the hamlet of North Creek and Riparius, between Main Street (County Route 77) and State Route 8. Leaving the paved portion towards Route 8 at 40 mph as signage is already in place.

# AFSCO CONTRACT - TENNIS COURT REPAIR

Supervisor Vanselow stated that two of the quotes on the Tennis Court repair at the Ski Bowl was \$20,000 or better, AFSCO came in several thousand dollars less because they believe they can reuse some of the fencing parts. The insurance company is very happy with that quote. We do have a \$1,000 deductable. Mr. Stevens asked if we had any references for AFSCO Fence. Supervisor Vanselow stated he believes they have worked for us before. Mr. Olesheski stated that was good we are moving forward with the fence but what about the Snack Shack? Mr. Arsenault asked if there was anything else that we need to do. Supervisor Vanselow stated not that he is a aware of, just the Snack Shack.
